THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Board hereby rejects all bids pursuant to <u>N.J.S.A.</u> 18A:18A-22(a) and (b) and further authorizes the Business Administrator/Purchasing Agent to rebid for Evening and Summer Custodial Cleaning Services.
